2012 Home Block single Vineyard Pinot Noir

Tasting Notes

Dark, deep ruby-red colour with purple hues. This has a full and evenly expressed bouquet of ripe dark raspberry and red cherry aromas. The nose is a little restrained with subtle reductive mineral notes present, gradually unfolding dark herbal nuances with oak toast and perfumed florals. Medium-bodied, rich and lusciously concentrated flavours of dark berry and raspberry fruit form a dense core. The mouthfeel has a slipperiness and sweetness, and the palate is very smooth flowing. Fine-grained tannins are in the background and lively acidity provides tension and energy.

Though tightly bound, the concentration and linearity carry through to a very long, firm and fine finish with raspberry fruit, minerals and spice elements.

This is an elegant, tightly bound, lively and slippery Pinot Noir with raspberry and mineral flavours.

Match with poultry and pork dishes and with Asian fare over the next 5-6 years.
